SUNSET RIDGE COUNTRY CLUB

Welcome to Sunset Ridge Country Club!

We recently completed award winning renovations to our clubhouse facilities and golf course. In addition, the pool complex, paddle tennis facilities and our skeet and trap building have all been renovated or were constructed new in just the last few years. Sunset Ridge was awarded the 2006 Private Club Golf Course Renovation of the Year by *Golf, Inc.* magazine.

The course was designed by William Diddel in 1922, renovated by Rick Jacobsen in 2004-05, and features tight fairways and fast, pure bent grass greens. Shot placement is critical for a good score and it is always wise to stay below the pins on our greens. Sunset Ridge Country Club offers a unique golfing experience.

BAG DROP:

Upon your arrival, follow the driveway to the rear of the clubhouse to the designated area near the driving range.

LOCKERS:

The men's locker room is located to the left of the main entrance or it can be accessed through the golf pro shop. The Ladies' locker room entrance is to the right of the clubhouse main entrance. An attendant will assign you to a locker upon arrival.

ATTIRE:

Proper golf attire for men and women is required at all times, including collared shirts for men; Bermuda length golf shorts (cargo style, tennis and cut-off shorts are not permitted). Blue jeans, tee shirts and tank tops are not allowed. We request that golf shirts be tucked in at all times and golf caps be worn with the bill of the cap facing forward.

CELL PHONES:

While the usage of cell phones is not prohibited, discretion is extremely important. Setting phones on silent ring or vibrate is strongly encouraged. Please err on the side of caution.

PAGE OF PLAY:

Ideally, four ball matches playing 18 holes should take four hours or less.

CADDIES:

Sunset Ridge is dedicated to maintaining our nationally recognized caddie program. The Club's long standing support for caddies dates back to its earliest days, and caddies are an integral part of the Sunset Ridge experience.

SEVERE WEATHER:

If lightning is detected within five miles, a signal will sound indicating that it is not safe to remain on the course. The signal used for taking shelter is a continuous 15 second solid siren tone. Once the Golf Shop staff sounds the weather siren, golf play is to stop immediately, with the caddies dropping the bags and both the player and caddie seeking the nearest point of shelter until the weather siren blasts again. Points of shelter include the clubhouse, 4th tee pump house, 7th tee shelter, and the golf course maintenance facilities to the east of the 8th tee.

FROM THE NORTH (EDEN'S EXPRESSWAY): Exit at I-43 Waukegan Road South (first exit after toll) to Willow Road. Turn left on Willow (East) to Sunset Ridge Road. Turn left onto Sunset Ridge Road (North) to Club.

FROM THE SOUTH (EDEN'S EXPRESSWAY): Exit at Willow Road West to Sunset Ridge Road. Turn right onto Sunset Ridge Road (North) to Club.

FROM THE SOUTH I-294: Exit at Willow Road East to Sunset Ridge Road. Turn left onto Sunset Ridge Road (North) to Club.

FROM THE NORTH (US 41): Exit at Lake Cook Road exit and turn right (West) onto Lake Cook. Turn left (South) onto Skokie Blvd (first stop light). Turn right (South) onto Sunset Ridge Road to Club.
